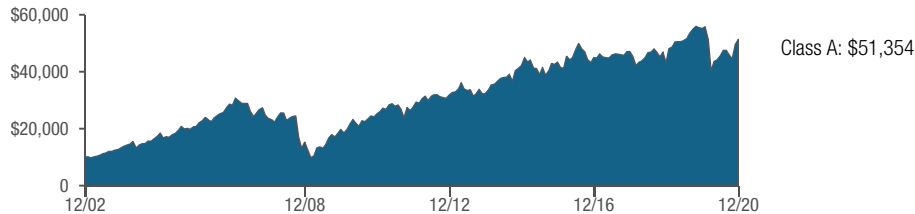

Before You Invest

Before considering an investment in the Fund, you should understand that you could lose money.

Investments in REITs involve risks associated with direct ownership of real estate, including decline in property values, extended vacancies, increases in property taxes and changes in interest rates. Investments in the real estate sector have many of the same risks as direct ownership of real estate, including the risk that the value of real estate could decline due to a variety of factors that affect the real estate market generally.

Small and mid-cap stocks are often more volatile than large-cap stocks. Because the Fund concentrates its investments in securities issued by companies principally engaged in the real estate industry, the Fund may be subject to greater risks and market fluctuations than a fund whose portfolio has exposure to a broader range of industries. Other risks of the fund include: Private Placement and Restricted Securities Risk. Convertible Securities Risk and Initial Public Offering Risk.

Class R shares are available only through corporate-sponsored retirement plans. **2.** The FTSE Nareit All Equity REITs Index is a free-float adjusted, market capitalization-weighted index of U.S. equity REITs. Constituents of the index include all tax-qualified REITs with more than 50 percent of total assets in qualifying real estate assets other than mortgages secured by real property. The Fund has selected a tiered benchmark as its secondary benchmark. The returns for the tiered benchmark represent the returns of the MSCI U.S. REIT® Index prior to January 1, 2021 and the returns of the FTSE Nareit All Equity REITs Index thereafter. Index results assume the reinvestment of all capital gain and dividend distributions. An investment cannot be made directly into an index. **3. Standard deviation** measures how widely dispersed a fund's returns have been over a specified period of time. A high standard deviation indicates that the range is wide, implying greater potential for volatility. **Alpha** measures a fund's risk-adjusted performance and is expressed as an annualized percentage. **Beta** is a measure of historical volatility relative to an appropriate index (benchmark) based on its investment objective. A beta greater than 1.00 indicates volatility greater than the benchmark's. **R-Squared** measures the percentage of a fund's movements that result from movements in the index. The **Sharpe Ratio** shown is calculated for the past 36-month period by dividing annualized excess returns by annualized standard deviation. The **Annual Turnover Rate** is as of the most recent annual shareholder report. **Information Ratio** measures the returns above the returns of a benchmark to the volatility of those returns. **Tracking Error** measures the difference between the return fluctuations of a portfolio and the benchmark. **Price to FFO** is the REIT equivalent of a security's Price-to-Earnings ratio and is used to measure operating performance, which encompasses a REIT's net income, excluding gains or losses from sales of property, and adding back real estate depreciation.
