The Fund commenced operations in May 2024 after the conversion of a separately managed account (the "Predecessor Account") into shares of the Fund. The Fund has adopted the performance history of the Predecessor Account. Pursuant to the conversion, the Predecessor Account transferred substantially all of its assets to the Fund. MacKay Shields LLC, the Fund's Subadvisor, managed the Predecessor Account for the entire performance period shown. Prior to the conversion, the Fund had not yet commenced operations. The Predecessor Account commenced operations on October 1, 2019. The Fund's objectives, policies, guidelines and restrictions are, in all material respects, equivalent to those of the Predecessor Account. However, the Predecessor Account was not registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940 (the "1940 Act") and therefore was not subject to certain restrictions imposed by the 1940 Act on registered investment companies and by the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 on regulated investment companies. 


