

# 4 Things Investors Need to Know About AI






## All is transforming the world by performing things from everyday tasks to life-saving surgeries. But where are the biggest opportunities for investors?

#### 2 How Much Is Invested in AI on a Global Scale?


In 2024, Al investment totaled \$252 billion. Though shy of the \$361 billion peak in 2021, renewed growth in U.S. and European markets highlights Al's resurgence as a major driver of innovation and capital.



Al demands not only vast financial resources, but also significant amounts of power and water.

### 3 How Much Power Demand Is AI-Driven? Share of total U.S. power demand (%)

Beyond capital investment, Al-driven data centers consume vast resources—especially electricity and water. By 2030, their demand for data center capacity could triple, intensifying pressure on global infrastructure.



#### 4 How Did Data Center REITs Perform in 2024?


Amid the Al-driven data center boom, data center REITs are drawing attention—rising 25.2% in 2024, outpacing the broader REIT sector's 4.9% gain.
