Objective

Epoch Investment Partners, Inc. ("Epoch") seeks to provide a high level of income by investing in a globally diversified portfolio of stocks with a history of attractive dividends and positive growth in free cash flow, which may be used to pay future dividends.

Investment process

Epoch's Global Equity Yield strategy pursues attractive total returns with an above-average level of income by investing in a diversified portfolio of global companies with strong and growing free cash flow. Companies in the portfolio possess managements that focus on creating value for shareholders through consistent and rational capital allocation policies with an emphasis on cash dividends, share repurchases and debt reduction — the key components of shareholder yield. The portfolio generally holds between 90 and 120 stocks from equity markets worldwide, with risk controls to diversify the sources of shareholder yield and minimize volatility. Epoch may give consideration to certain environmental, social, and governance ("ESG") criteria when evaluating an investment opportunity.

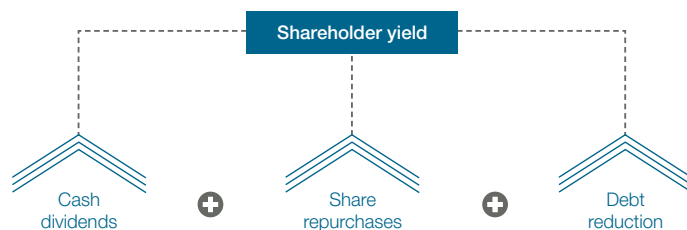

- A company should reinvest capital if the expected return on invested capital is greater than the company's cost of capital
- Remaining free cash flow should be returned to shareholders via shareholder yield



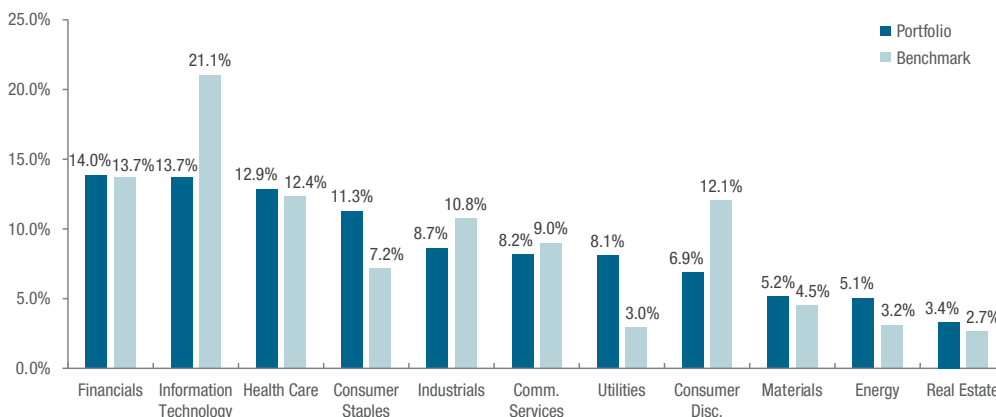
